

## DOMAINE FREY PINOT BLANC

**Appellation:** Alsace AOC, France  
**Vintage:** 2006  
**Winemaker:** Charles and Dominique Frey  
**Varietal:** 100% Pinot Blanc

**Certificate:** Grapes and facilities have been certified organic by USDA Accredited-ECOCERT and certified biodynamic by Demeter.



**Notes:** Brilliant, light straw-gold in color. On the nose, apple and pear notes, with faint scents of cinnamon and flowers. The wine is medium bodied, creamy and plump. Flavors of ripe peach, pineapple, and white raisin, are underlain with a fresh minerality that lingers on the long and clean finish. Expressions of light vanilla bean and hazelnut on the back palate. Enjoy with creamy pasta dishes, Pad Thai, and Butternut Squash Bisque with Blue Crab.

**The Estate:** The Frey family estate is located in Dambach la Ville, 25 miles south of Strasbourg. With a total population of 2000, it is the largest wine producing area in all of Alsace. Father and son team, Charles and Dominique Frey, currently cultivate 25 acres of vineyards which are spread over the local areas of Dambach la Ville, Scherwiller, and Chatenois et Albe. The vines grow on granite sandstone where the roots must force their way through the rock to find humidity. The main varietals grown on the estate are Pinot Blanc, Riesling, Sylvaner, and Pinot Noir. In 1997, Charles and Dominique made the decision to practice organic viticulture and viniculture. They abide by the strict organic guidelines of USDA Accredited Ecocert in the cultivation of their vineyards. All synthetic fertilizers, pesticides, and herbicides are forbidden. Domaine Frey has been developing their biodynamic category as well, using vegetable, animal, and mineral preparations that are pulverized and used according to the needs and the growth patterns of the plants.
