

## ORGANIC VINTNERS ROUGE

**Appellation:** Languedoc, France

**Varietal:** Carignan, Cinsault, Tempranillo

**Certificate:** Grapes and facilities have been certified by USDA Accredited ECOCERT (France) and are compliant with the National Organic Program (NOP) of the U.S. Department of Agriculture.



**Notes:** An ideal wine for everyday. The nose is floral and spicy. On the palate, cherry and strawberry notes emerge with elements of spice, baked herbs and black licorice. The finish is simple and clean. Pairing suggestions: Great with Wild Boar and mushrooms or Roquefort and country bread.

**The Estate:** Situated between the three towns of Béziers, Pézénan, and Bédarieux, the DOMAINE BASSAC vineyards cover some 60 hectares (150 acres) with a range of soil types around Poussalicon and the neighboring village of Thézan-les-Béziers. By taking into account the specific nature of the individual *terroir*—a combination of climate, soil, and landscape—each varietal is planted in the vineyard that suits it best. As a result, the varietal blending at BASSAC is diverse and original which enable the three Delhon brothers, Henri, Pierre, and Louis, to make a broad range of wines. Blended, racked and clarified, the wines are estate bottled.
